Powfoot Golf Course

Laid out by the prolific James Braid at the beginning of the last century (the club was formed in 1903), the 6283 yards of this links course are woven across part of an undulating plain of sand. Excellent use of the land has been made and the neighbouring holes are frequently screened from the golfers' view as they play along the low links between high gorse-topped dunes. The 8th and 11th are prime examples of this.

In dry weather this is classic bump and run territory and when the wind blows across the Irish sea and the Solway Firth then you will find a taste of the game for which the Home of Golf is so renowned. The greens are ample. The main hazards are gorse and some large bunkers. Some holes are easy (17th), some holes are dangerous (2nd) and others are just downright pleasant (6th). Mind you, it's not often you play a hole which has been bombed! Better watch for that crater at the 9th - it's deep.

Local courses worth considering when planning your stay with us.

We have over thirty golf courses across Dumfries & Galloway.

Dumfries & County Golf Club

18 holes, 5918 yards, Par 69, SSS 69

A beautiful 18 hole course in undulating parkland bordering the River Nith where Robert Burns used to walk.

Dumfries & Galloway Golf Club

18 holes, 6309 yards, Par 70, SSS 71

A challenging and varied 18 hole course set on the outskirts of Dumfries.

Thornhill Golf Club

18 holes, 6085 yards, Par 71, SSS 70

A mix of parkland and heathland in Mid Nithsdale about 25 miles from the hotel. The journey is well worth it for this interesting course surrounded by wonderful scenery. The rare red squirrel is still seen in some of the wooded areas.

Lockerbie Golf Club

18 holes, 5418 yards, Par 67, SSS 67

The 18 hole parkland course is in an open agricultural setting with some water hazards, which add to the challenge.

Southernness Golf Club

18 holes, 6566 yards, Par 69, SSS 73

Championship links course. The heather and gorse together with the prevailing south-westerly wind make this excellent course a real challenge. Not recommended for beginners but considered by many to be the jewel in the crown of golf in Dumfries & Galloway.

Colvend Golf Club

18 holes, 5250 yards, Par 69, SSS 67

This shorter-than average course, which was extended to 18 holes, has received regular praise from our visiting parties. A little hilly in parts but you will be rewarded with the same wonderful views as its illustrious nearby neighbour, Southernness.

Lochmaben Golf Club

18 holes, 5954 yards, Par 70, SSS 70

Occupying an historic area around the Kirk Loch, this is an 18 hole parkland course and is one of our most scenic courses. The area has deep associations with Robert the Bruce.

Moffat Golf Club

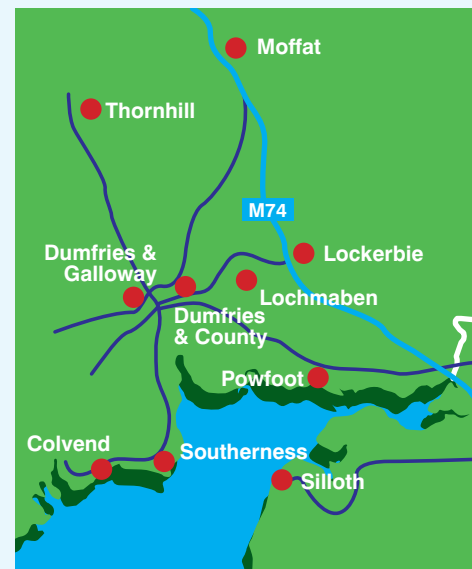
18 holes, 5218 yards, Par 69, SSS 67

A lovely upland course designed by Ben Sayers and opened in 1884. This can be a real test with the direction and strength of the wind adding to the challenge. The absolutely outstanding views alone make the 22 mile journey from Powfoot worthwhile.

Silloth-on-Solway Golf Club

18 holes, 6070 yards, SSS 70

On the other side of the Solway in Cumbria this is one of England's finest links courses. Playing Silloth, Powfoot and Southernness will give you a real feast of links golf.

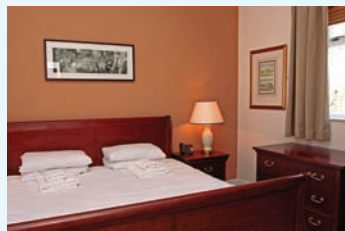
Most of our bedrooms are located on the first floor with a mixture of the traditional features in the old house and more modern proportions and appointments in the new wing. How to find us...

Powfoot is located west of Annan along the shore of the Solway Firth.

To reach us from the East and M6/M74: Follow the A75 from Gretna to just west of Annan where the sign directs you to Powfoot along the B721 and B724 (for 2.3 miles) whereupon you reach a left turning into Powfoot. Follow over the railway bridge into the village of Powfoot, over the Pow Burn bridge, along Solway Terrace to the shore (White Row). Powfoot Golf Hotel is straight ahead at the end of the row of cottages.

To reach us from the West, Dumfries and the A75: Follow the A75 to Annan to where the sign directs you to Powfoot along the B721 and B724 (for 2.3 miles) whereupon you reach a left turning into Powfoot. Follow over the railway bridge into the village of Powfoot, over the Pow Burn bridge, along Solway Terrace to the shore (White Row). Powfoot Golf Hotel is straight ahead at the end of the row of cottages.
